## Penn Township Municipal Dog Park Rules

- 1. This is a use-at-your-own risk, non-supervised facility. The Township of Penn does not assume any responsibility for loss or injury. Owners / handlers are responsible and liable for the actions and behavior of their dogs at all times.
- 2. All dogs must display a current license, vaccination tag, and ID tag on their collars at all times when in the dog park and other areas of the Municipal Park.
- 3. All dogs must be under the control of an adult 18 years of age or older, and there is a limit of two (2) dogs per handler in the park. Handlers must be present with their dog(s) and keep them under visual and voice control at all times.
- 4. No children under the age of 18 are permitted unless accompanied by an adult. Children have a tendency to scream and run when excited which can trigger a dog's natural instinct to chase. For this reason and for the safety of your children, we do not recommend bringing small children or infants into the dog park.
- 5. Handlers must have a leash in-hand at all times while in the off-leash area, and dogs must be on-leash when entering or exiting the off-leash area or other park areas.
- 6. Dogs in heat, ill and/or with internal or external parasites (fleas, ticks, worms) are not permitted in the park.
- 7. Dog waste must be collected by the handler and placed in the provided receptacles. Dog owners must fill any holes that their dog digs.
- 8. No rawhide, dog treats, or food for pets or humans is permitted in the off-leash areas.
- 9. If a dog becomes aggressive, it must be immediately leashed and removed at the FIRST sign of aggression towards other dogs or people.
- 10. No animals other than dogs are permitted within any fenced areas of the dog park.
- 11. Penn Township, at its discretion may close the facility and/or restrict entry for any circumstances deemed, including disorderly conduct, disturbance of the peace, violations of these rules or other unsafe behavior.
- 12. For emergencies, call 911. To report damage, hazardous conditions, concerns, or comments, call the Township of Penn at 724-744-2171.
- 13. All other park regulations including dusk to dawn closure are in effect.
